Hi John,

a Headless Exception is raised, if the headless version (that is the one without user interface classes) of the Java Runtime environment is installed instead of the regular JRE. The headless JRE is meant for servers without Desktop user interface, that need to run some Java based services.

I am not exactly sure, but I assume that you can run DataWarrior on such a server nevertheless, if you log into the server from another computer with e.g. "ssh -X john@server.org" the -X option tells the server to use the client computer for all userinterface activities as opening windows, tracking mouse movements etc.
