## Hello,

I am trying to retrive a table from a Postgresql (v12) database installed on a local host. As connecting string, I am using the following: postgresql://127.0.0.1:50036/chemicals because 127.0.0.1 is my local IP;, 50036 is the port; chemicals is the name of the database. In the SQL string, I put: SELECT \* FROM pure\_components; because I want to retrive the whole table named "pure\_components".

If I use the same parameters, I can connect and retrive the table in python, so it seems they are correct. However, when I use them in Datawarrior via "Run Data from SQI-Database...", the software allows to dial user and password (I use: postgres and mypassword) but then it freezes. No way to start it again and I have to stop the process. I suppose some parameters are supplied in a wrong way. My setup is quite common in a local installation. Any suggestion? Thanks
