the most recent public version 4.2.2 (for Mac) from summer 2015 comes on with its own Java 1.8.0\_51 based runtime.  
Earlier version were indeed based on 1.6, which was the last JRE provided by Apple. For some time new JREs were not available or were not properly supporting platform integration as icons and file types. Your DataWarrior.app/Contents/PlugIns folder should contains a folder jdk1.8.0\_51. If this is not the case, most likely you have an older DataWarrior version.
