This is now fixed. In DataWarrior the String "; " and a '/n' are allowed data separators. The code to separate the string here was too lazy and also separated at a single semicolon. Now it is more strict to require at least one SPACE after the semicolon.

In addition, when directly clicking the link in a DataWarrior cell, the content was not URL encoded. Therefore the semicolon caused a problem. Now cell content will be encoded unless the column properties section contains a line like:

```

The change is deployed in the current dev update.
