You may download a debug version 'DataWarrior_d.exe' from openmolecules.org/datawarrior/dw550_d.zip. Then unpack and copy these files into the DataWarrior installation directory. Make sure, none of the new files is blocked. Then start DataWarrior_d.exe from the command line. Any messages?
