I don't have many ideas left. You may do this: download a debug version of DataWarrior v600 from [openmolecules.org/datawarrior/datawarrior600d.zip](https://openmolecules.org/datawarrior/datawarrior600d.zip), unpack it and put the DataWarrior\_d.exe into C:\Program Files\DataWarrior. Then start it from the command line (make sure in the properties dialog that it is not locked). If the debug exe is launched, it will produce much more messages than the normal DataWarrior.exe. From them, we might learn something. If there are no messages, then most likely the file is prevented from being launched by some other mechanism in the OS, security software, anti-virus, ...
