Hi Dave,

In the current version you cannot do that, unfortunately. I was considering once to extend the form view such that one could use view splitting like in the 2D-view. Then you could define a simple form with a few alpha-numerical columns, which would be displayed multiple times in a grid with R1 and R2 on the axes. In reality, one would need zooming functionality and scroll bars, because the number of Substituents after a SAR deconvolution often is larger than what would fit on a screen or printout. Also numbers shown would often need to be summarized, i.e. mean values because of the underlying multiplicity. Do you think, this is what you are looking for?

Currently, the only thing that comes close would be a graphical view split by R1 and R2 as the following:
