Hi Stacy, DataWarrior often uses the right mouse button for context specific functionality. When pressing that button within a main view or within the header of a main view, for instance, opens different popup menus. The structure list area beneath "Define scaffold structures" in another example. A popup gives you options to add individual sub-structures per editor, open structures from a file, save the list, etc.

On the Macintosh this may be less obvious, because many programs don't use the concept of a right mouse button. Depending on how your Mac is configured and whether you use a mouse or touchpad, you may press Ctrl-mouse, click the right bottom area of the touch pad, or something else. I have my MacBookPro setup to interpret right bottom area clicks on the touchpad as right mouse clicks.
