For txt files DataWarrior needs a first line to contain TAB separated column names. The column that contains the encoded structure (called idcodes) must be named 'idcode' or it should end with '[idcode]' for DataWarrior to show structure. dwar files, the native DataWarrior files' are much more flexible, but also much more complicated. Thus, keep/use the 'txt' extension and make sure that you have the key word 'idcode' in the first line and correct column.
