it seems you open the datawarrior.xml file for some reason in the browser. DataWarrior is not a browser application and to start the program you should execute the shell script '/opt/datawarrior/datawarrior' or any file link associated with it. You may try opening a shell and type 'cd /opt/datawarrior', then type './datawarrior'. See whether you still get an error. If not and if the program starts.
