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when using the mapping tool, you are supposed to press the mouse over a reactant atom and then draw the mouse while still pressing over the respective product atom. When you release now, both atoms are assigned.

In you encounter bugs, you may also try to use the most recent development version, which should have all known bug fixed, but may introduce new functionality and (potentially) new bugs. You may download updated exe/jar files for Windows/OSX&Linux under these links: openmolecules.org/datawarrior/dw500win.zip and [dw500x.zip](http://openmolecules.org/datawarrior/dw500x.zip). Just unpack the zip file and put the files it contains into you installation folder, where they should replace the original files.
