The box plot (as all other plots) use the default category sort order, which is alphabetical for text categories and numerical for numerical categories.

However, you may define a custom category order:

- in the table view on the respective category column header press the right mouse button
 - select 'Set Category Custom Order...'
 - in the dialog select 'Use Custom Order'. Then you may
 - manually drag and drop categories to re-order the list
 - or select other criteria as 'in ascending order by mean of <some other column> and press 'Sort categories'
 - Press OK and you have changed the category order in all views
