if you put an a-tag like `click this to start macro` into the html of an explanation view, and if you have a macro with the same name (in this case 'mymacro'), then the macro is triggered when the link is clicked (requires DataWarrior v06.02.04, which will be release in the upcoming days).

With the plugin API you can add custom functionality to DataWarrior, which can be embedded into macros and, thus be triggered by the mechanism above...
